On 06/20/09, I responded to 617 N Berkeley Blvd to assist Officer Prevost in a vehicle search for illegal drugs. Lucky was deployed and went straight into the driver door which was open upon arrival. Lucky alerted to the middle console of the vehicle. 15 grams of cocaine and \$1250 were found inside the console. The driver was already handcuffed and in the back seat for D.W.I. K-9 Lucky also alerted on the back trunk area where speakers were found. The vehicle was towed and stored by Willie's Radiator until a thorough search will be performed. The cash and drugs were seized and taken into evidence by Officer Prevost.

On 06/24/09 I assisted Support Services in serving a search warrant at 405 Day Circle. K-9 Lucky and I went through the back of the 300 and 400 building following Sgt. Lynch. I heard Sgt. Lynch to detain the subject by the 300 building wearing the black ball cap. I jumped out leaving Lucky in the car until Officer McIntyre got control of him. I then left him with Officer McIntyre and retrieved K-9 Lucky. I ran upstairs to help secure the residence. I heard Officer Collins and Ravine state everything was clear. Officer Collins stated there was a young child in the back bedroom. I then waited for Officer Young to read the search warrant to one of the suspect's. I then entered with K-9 Lucky and he pulled me to the back bedroom where he began to frantically search. He and I praised him and continue to search. I then took him to the other rooms but he gave no alerts. I took him back and into the back bedroom. He again positively alerted on a drawer. Officer Young opened the drawer and we observed a large bag of green vegetable matter. I praised Lucky and took him outside. I then took him out and performed a search of the suspect's car because it was in the pva of the apartment complex. Lucky made a positive alert and he was rewarded and put up. A bag of green leafy matter was found in the console of that vehicle. I informed Sgt Chiero and Officer Young photographed and collected the evidence. The amount was 2lbs.of weed, 2 gms of cocaine and \$190 cash. In the past month Lucky has help locate almost \$80,000 worth of dope and cash.
