**On June 2, 2009 K-9 Lucky and I responded to Fairview Circle to assist our Housing Division on narcotic searches. Lucky was deployed and I began my search in the living room area. Lucky indicated on the cushion of the green couch. A roach of marijuana was found. Several unused blunt cigars and sandwich bags were also located where the suspect G. Jackson was sitting. Lucky also alerted on the freezer and kitchen table where more marijuana and scales were found. A locked safe was found in the closet in the living room where Mr. Jackson was. The safe was then taken out of the closet and blended into the contents of the room. Lucky came back downstairs and was given the command to find drugs. He sniffed the room and when he came to the safe he immediately alerted on it. Permission was granted to open the safe. Nothing was inside the safe but the suspect admitted he had recently been there. A total of 23 grams of marijuana was seized. About two hours later I was responded again with K-9 Lucky for another search at another residence on the same street. When I entered there was a substance in a white pill bottle on the table in the kitchen. I had Officer Young open the bottle and hide it in the kitchen somewhere to determine if it was narcotics without Lucky accidentally ingesting any. Lucky and I were in the living room when she did this. We entered the kitchen and began to look for narcotics. He alerted on the cabinet where Officer Young put the bottle. Lucky then immediately turned his head and alerted on a plastic bag on the table. We then opened it and there was a large amount of grain white rice inside with a large plastic bag full of a powder substance. Another bag was discovered during the search where hundreds of small "bindles" were found. Wayne Drug squad arrived and determined that the rice filled bag contained the**

**Heroin. It was weighed it came up to 2.39 oz. The value was estimated at \$70,000. The two suspects are being charged federally for level 3 trafficking.**
